
The Residences at Mandarin Oriental, Honolulu - \$35 Million

The Residences at Mandarin Oriental, Honolulu will boast the most expensive penthouse for the island, the Hale Nani (Hawaiian for glory). Designed by arguably one of the best design teams on the planet, architecture by au Workshop, interior design by Diana Wong, and landscape by Hart Howerton, the home has approximately 6,000 square-foot of living space, four bedrooms and four-and-a-half bathrooms, as well as 647-square-foot lanai area. Residents of the penthouse will enjoy 270-degree views of the Pacific Ocean, Diamond Head and Waikiki. Legendary Mandarin Oriental amenities at the residences include access to world-class shopping and dining, as well as the largest spa in all of Oahu, a theater, recording studio, karaoke room, golf simulation room, chapel and more.

Located in the heart of Tribeca on a charming cobblestone street, this 6,207 sqft. duplex penthouse boasts 5 bedrooms and 6.5 bathrooms with unbeatable views and light. In addition to nearly 1,500 square feet of private outdoor space, this state-of-the-art residence features separate air control, perimeter radiant heating, electronic and video intercom systems, as well as an individually-wired security system by American Security, a pre-wired Cloud9 system, and a Lutron home automation system. Amenities within the boutique condominium include an on-site fitness center, storage, private residential lounge and more.
